POWER GROUPS – SEPTEMBER 27th

OVERVIEW:

Last week we answered the question, "How Great is Our God?" by observing many of God's 80 questions to Job (Job 38:1-40:2). God's questions to Job demonstrated His supreme greatness and trustworthiness. This questioning helped Job to see God's power, provision, purposes, and control over all of creation, including his own suffering. We overserved from God's questions to Job that He is greater in Size, Experience, Wisdom, and Power than mankind.

OBSERVE THE WORD:

Look at one or two of the following verse sections from Job 38-39 and discuss together how awesome God is. What about these questions was God trying to communicate to Job? Let the questions capture your imaginations regarding God's greatness.

APPLICATION QUESTIONS:

How should we respond to the greatness of God? We concluded that we should respond with **respect for God**, **humility before God**, and **knowledge of God**.

- **Respect for God:** What are ways we tend to worship ourselves instead of God? What are ways to cultivate a deeper respect for God?
- Humility before God: How might a proud heart respond, when confronted with the
 greatness of God? How does this contrast to the way a humble heart responds to God's
 greatness? How should an awareness of God's greatness change how we act toward
 others?
- **Knowledge of God:** What are things we tend to pursue hard after? What are practical ways to pursue hard after a greater and deeper knowledge of God?
