- James 3:1-12 Today we begin a 3 week focus on "Wise Words" from James 3:1-12. James brings up the tongue as a focal point of authentic Christianity. REDEEMED PEOPLE USE WORDS TO PRAISE GOD

Psalm 96 [Pastor Joel]

Oh sing to the Lord a new song; sing to the Lord, all the earth! ² Sing to the Lord, bless his name; tell of his salvation from day to day. ³Declare his glory among the nations, his marvelous works among all the peoples! ⁴ For great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; he is to be feared above all gods. ⁵ For all the gods of the peoples are worthless idols, but the Lord made the heavens. ⁶ Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and beauty are in his sanctuary. ⁷*Ascribe to the Lord, O families of the peoples,* ascribe to the Lord glory and strength! ⁸ Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts! ⁹ Worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness;^[a] tremble before him, all the earth! ¹⁰ Say among the nations, "The Lord reigns! Yes, the world is established; it shall never be moved; he will judge the peoples with equity." ¹¹Let the heavens be glad, and let the earth rejoice; let the sea roar, and all that fills it; 12 *let the field exult, and everything in it!* Then shall all the trees of the forest sing for joy 13 before the Lord, for he comes, for he comes to judge the earth. *He will judge the world in righteousness,* and the peoples in his faithfulness.

SCRIPTURE'S WISDOM ON THE POWER OF THE TONGUE

Reminders from Proverbs on the contrasting power of the tongue [Pastor Bernie]

Words can wound or heal

- Proverbs 12:18 *There is one whose rash words are like sword thrusts, but the tongue of the wise brings healing.*
- Proverbs 14:3 By the mouth of a fool comes a rod for his back, but the lips of the wise will preserve them.
- Proverbs 11:9 *With his mouth the godless man would destroy his neighbor, but by knowledge the righteous are delivered.*

Words are honest or deceitful

- Proverbs 12:17 Whoever speaks the truth gives honest evidence, but a false witness utters deceit.
- Proverbs 14:25 A truthful witness saves lives, but one who breathes out lies is deceitful.
- Proverbs 21:28 *A false witness will perish,* but the word of a man who hears will endure.

Words bring wisdom or folly

- Proverbs 10:31-32 The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom, but the perverse tongue will be cut off.³² The lips of the righteous know what is acceptable, but the mouth of the wicked, what is perverse.
- Proverbs 10:14 ¹⁴ The wise lay up knowledge, but the mouth of a fool brings ruin near.
- Proverbs 15:4 From the fruit of his mouth a man eats what is good, but the desire of the treacherous is for violence.

Message: Wise Words: The Useful Power of the Tongue (James 3:1-5a) [Pastor Steve]

Not many of you should become teachers, my brothers, for you know that we who teach will be judged with greater strictness. ² For we all stumble in many ways. And if anyone does not stumble in what he says, he is a perfect man, able also to bridle his whole body. ³ If we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they obey us, we guide their whole bodies as well. ⁴ Look at the ships also: though they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are guided by a very small rudder wherever the will of the pilot directs. ⁵ So also the tongue is a small member, yet it boasts of great things.

How great a forest is set ablaze by such a small fire! ⁶ And the tongue is a fire, a world of unrighteousness. The tongue is set among our members, staining the whole body, setting on fire the entire course of life,^[a] and set on fire by hell.^{[b] 7} For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and sea creature, can be tamed and has been tamed by mankind, ⁸ but no human being can tame the tongue. It is a restless evil, full of deadly poison. ⁹ With it we bless our Lord and Father, and with it we curse people who are made in the likeness of God. ¹⁰ From the same mouth come blessing and cursing. My brothers,^[c] these things ought not to be so. ¹¹ Does a spring pour forth from the same opening both fresh and salt water? ¹² Can a fig tree, my brothers, bear olives, or a grapevine produce figs? Neither can a salt pond yield fresh water.
