- Today we round out our study in Haggai by considering 2:20-23. We'll be drawn to remember the remarkable character of God as the One that perfectly keeps His Word and fulfils His promises. We will be pointed to Jesus, one who reigns and perfectly fulfils prophecy. God promised to David to establish His house. Through Haggai, God is recommitting himself to this promise which will take the form of a Son of David established as King. We know that this person is actually Jesus, but we also know that the fulness of this promise is still future.
