Message: Titus 2:10-16 [Pastor Steve]

¹⁰ For there are many who are insubordinate, empty talkers and deceivers, especially those of the circumcision party. ^[h] ¹¹ They must be silenced, since they are upsetting whole families by teaching for shameful gain what they ought not to teach. ¹² One of the Cretans, ^[i] a prophet of their own, said, "Cretans are always liars, evil beasts, lazy gluttons." ^[i] ¹³ This testimony is true. Therefore rebuke them sharply, that they may be sound in the faith, ¹⁴ not devoting themselves to Jewish myths and the commands of people who turn away from the truth. ¹⁵ To the pure, all things are pure, but to the defiled and unbelieving, nothing is pure; but both their minds and their consciences are defiled. ¹⁶ They profess to know God, but they deny him by their works. They are detestable, disobedient, unfit for any good work.
